Figure 1. Capital Input Contribution by Country

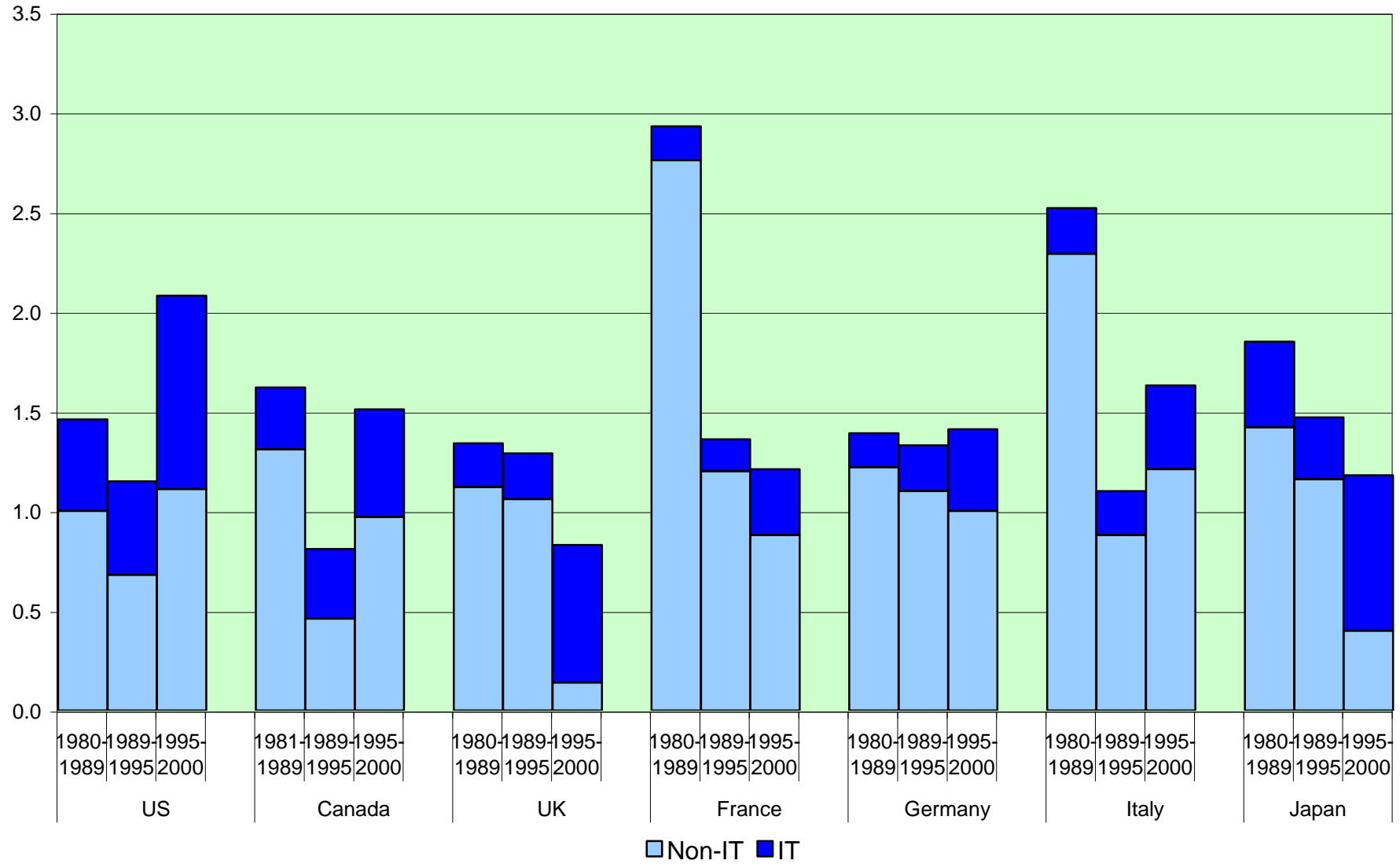


Figure 2. Sources of Productivity Growth by Country

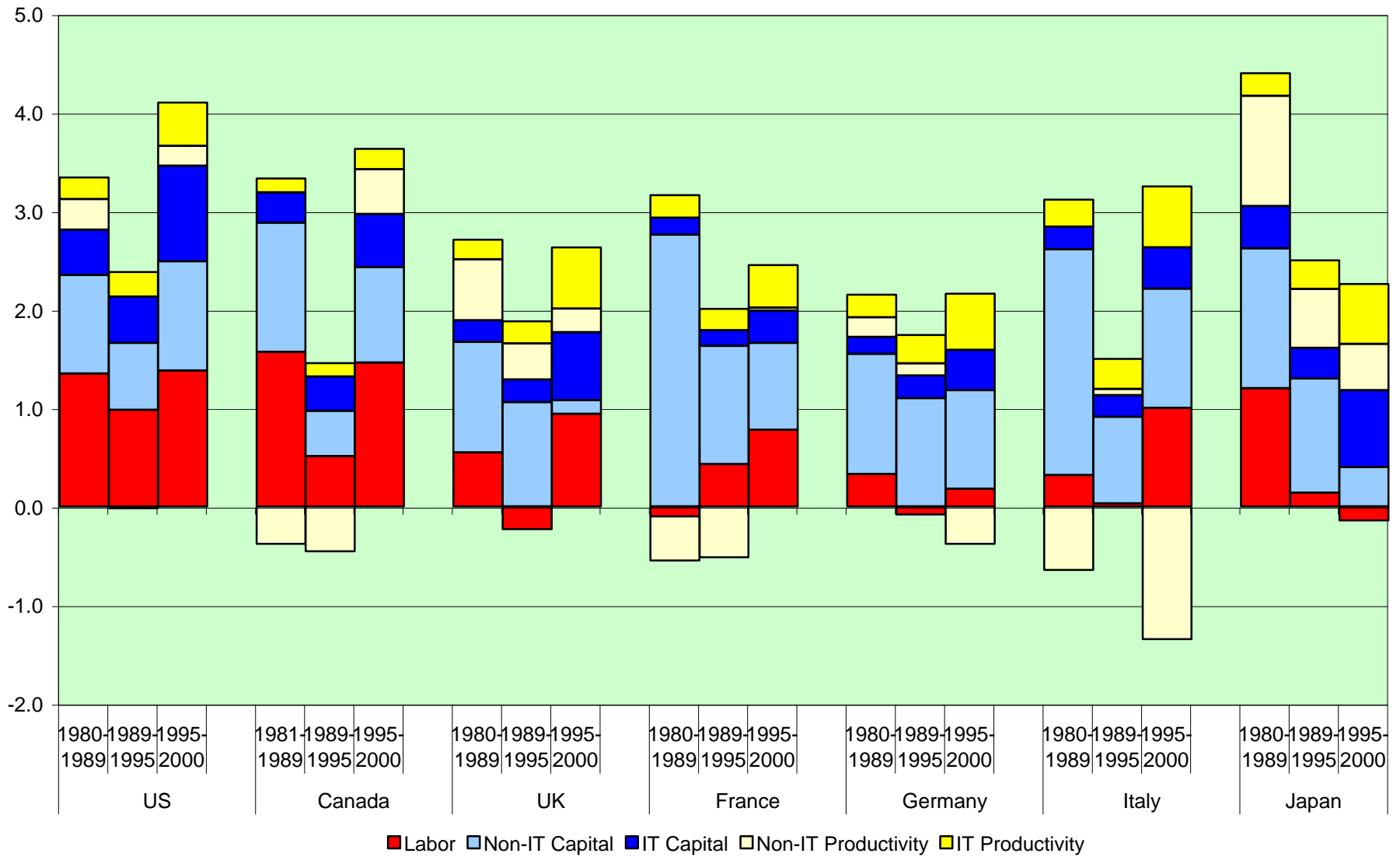


Figure 4. Sources of Labor Productivity Growth by Country
